
Nearly 50%

American Indians **are at an increased risk of poor health** due to a variety of social factors

American Indian Coloradans are more likely to have low incomes, low educational attainment, and be unemployed





24% of American Indians

in Colorado are in fair or poor health compared to 13% of Coloradans

The Indian Health Service provides health care and public health services to American Indians

The Indian Health Service has hospitals and clinics but also contracts with tribal facilities




Per Capita Health

48% of American Indians' health care needs are unmet due to a lack of IHS funds

Most American Indians in Colorado have coverage, but may struggle to access care
