1 in 8 Coloradans lives in Denver


Population Density

of all Colorado doctors practice in Denver


Among Denver residents:

18% have no usual source of care compared to 13% of Coloradans

> **54%** went to an emergency room for non-urgent care compared to 40% of Coloradans

are uninsured compared to 7% of Coloradans 10%

Of particular concern is the increased risk of early death for Denver residents



Despite having a more robust health care system than most of Colorado enjoys, many Denver residents are still in poor health. Together, we must work to understand and address the issues that are keeping residents from accessing care.
