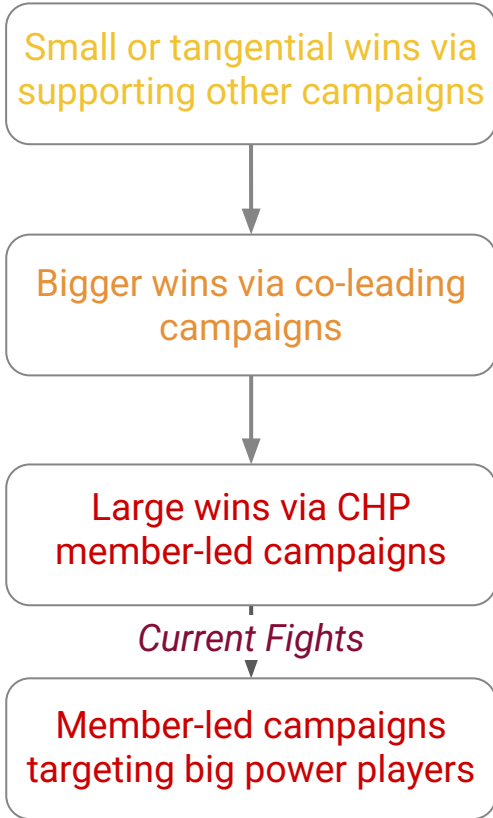


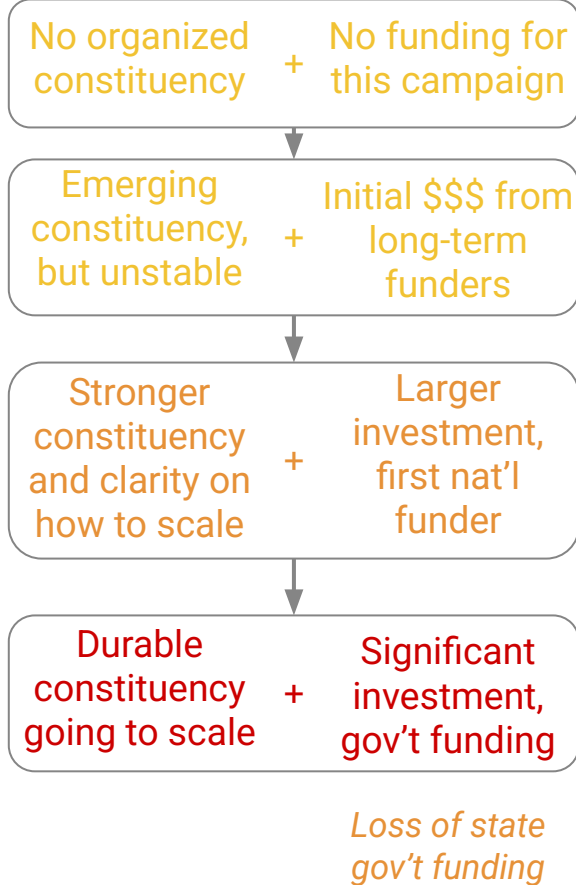

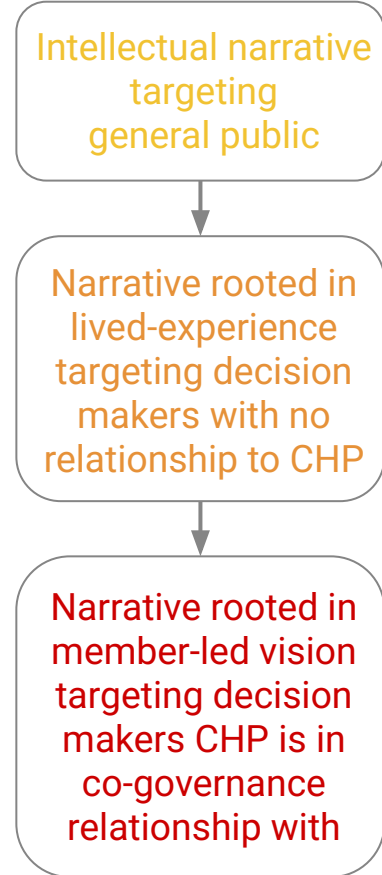

Structural Wins

- SB-188 - Improved driver's license access for immigrants (support)
- Rule change - Expanded Emergency Medicaid for dialysis (co-lead)
- Rule change - Emergency Medicaid for COVID-related care (co-lead)
- SB-131 - Strengthened data privacy across agencies (support)
- HB-1232 - Create OmniSalud program (co-lead)
- Repeal parts of HB-1023 (co-lead)

Current Fights

- Medicaid defense (lead/co-lead)
- Increase fee on health insurers to expand OmniSalud (lead/co-lead)

Power to Shape the Story

- **Public media campaign**
 - Immigrants belong
 - Colorado values
- **Data and policy framing**
 - Immigration policy is health policy
- **Directly influence decision makers**
 - Delayed care is costly
 - Challenge the worldview
- **Develop legislative and partner champions**
 - Immigrants must be part of coverage for all
- **Grow power under the dome / Co-governance**
 - Colorado is a leader nationally
 - Center directly impacted people in leadership
